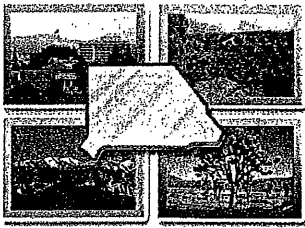

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 56706 of the California Government Code, you are hereby notified that the petition for the annexation of the territory to the City of San Bernardino, identified as LAFCO 3188, is sufficient. I have compared this landowner petition to the most current County Assessment Roll, as required by law, and made the following determinations:

Government Code Section 56767 specifies that a landowner petition initiating a city annexation must include 5% of the number of owners of land who also own at least 5% of the assessed value of land. The petition submitted meets the threshold, as identified above, having signatures of 45% of the landowners owning 52% of the land value.
