The planned land uses will not change as a result of annexation. This annexation is a change in administrative billing and contracting, not representing any changes from an operations or for development purposes.

The present and probable need for public facilities and services in the area.

No changes in public services providers or level of service are expected as part of this annexation.

The present capacity of public facilities and adequacy of public services that the agency to be expanded provides or is authorized to provide.

The San Bernardino County Fire Protection District would assume responsibility for the provision of fire protection and emergency medical services to the entire City of Adelanto community via the fire protection district instead of via contract services.

The existence of any social or economic communities of interest in the area.

The City of Adelanto is home to approximately 38,046 residents and faces significant social and economic challenges. The City's median household income is \$68,419, which is considerably lower than the California statewide median of \$95,521. This income disparity limits residents' access to essential services and reduces the City's ability to generate sufficient revenue for public service delivery. Adelanto also experiences a poverty rate of 16.4%, higher than the state average of 12%, indicating that a substantial portion of the population struggles to meet basic needs.

Educational attainment in Adelanto is also notably below state levels. Only 7.8% of the City's population holds a bachelor's degree or higher, compared to the statewide figure of 37.5%. Lower educational levels often correlate with reduced employment opportunities and long-term economic vulnerability, which in turn places greater reliance on public services such as fire protection, emergency response, and community safety.

The strain on local resources is evident in the City's fiscal structure. According to the adopted FY 2024–2025 budget, Adelanto allocates approximately \$6.2 million—or roughly 27% of its total expenditures—to contract county fire services. This substantial budget share underscores the critical role public safety plays in the community, but it also

highlights the financial burden of maintaining such services under limited economic capacity.

Enhancing service delivery through more optimized and stable regional partnerships would help the City better serve its disadvantaged residents and address the longstanding structural barriers to equitable service access.


